3. Must be accepted to an accredited college, university, vocational and/or trade school, or postsecondary institution for the fall of 2025.

The scholarship award is **\$500**, supported entirely by the generous contributions of our church membership.

The BBC Scholarship Committee is responsible for reviewing and awarding scholarships. A complete application must include:

- Completed application form
- Official high school transcript
- 400-word personal essay
